

HOUSE-DAY CEMETERY

GR103

off Old County Road (AKA House Road), from Lessner Road

overall site approximate 32' (N-S) x 40' (E-W)

Sadly, many stones in this cemetery were made from a fragile type of marble that has disintegrated into broken pieces and piles of "sugar" that are irreparable.

No documentation has been found showing the boundaries of the cemetery, the original layout of burials, or plot ownership. The boundaries used on this map are based on the location of stones found to date. Row and Lot numbers were assigned on this map to facilitate documentation of stone locations.

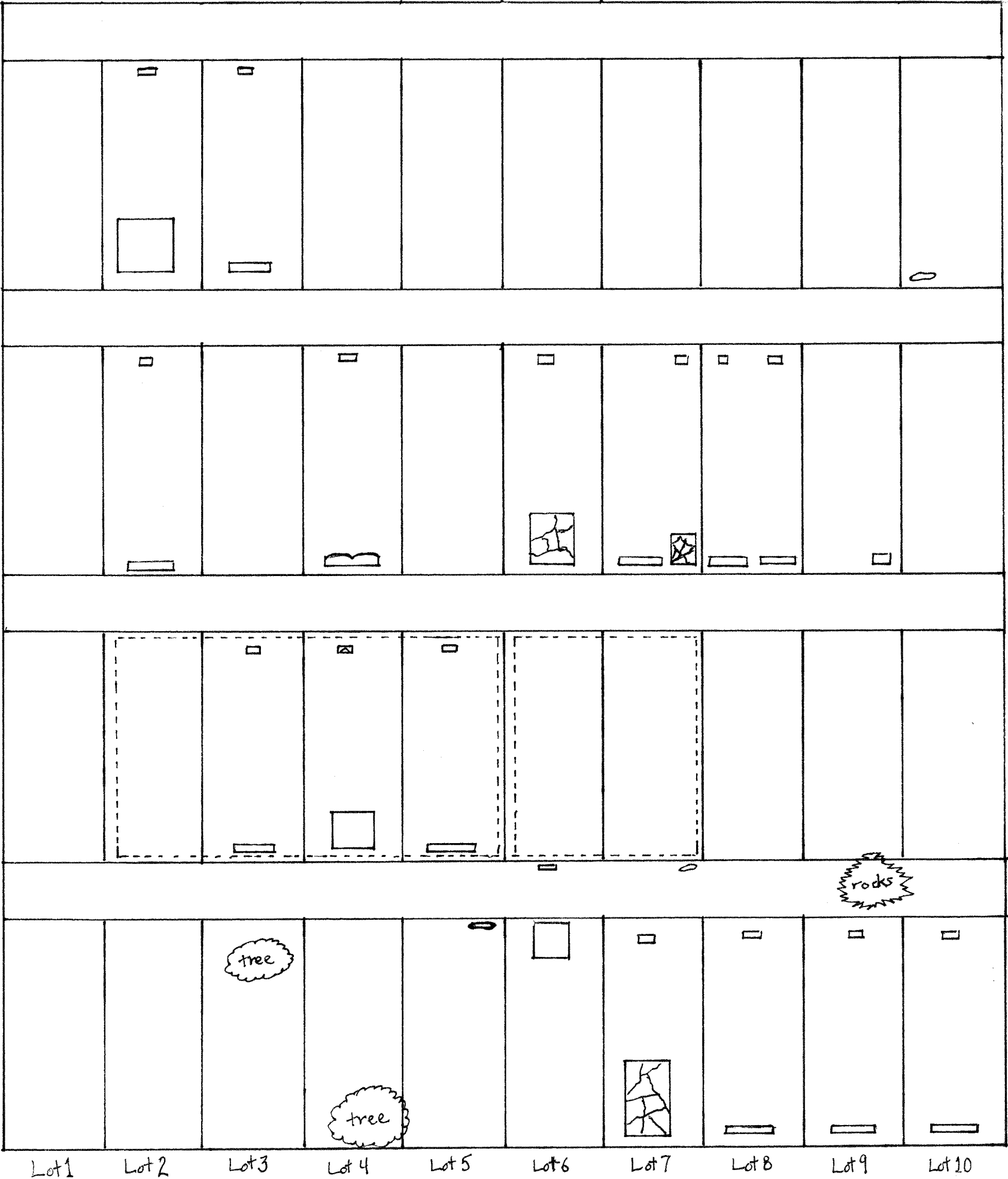
In addition to the raised area in Row 2, Lots 6 & 7, there appear to be unmarked burials in Row 2, Lots 8 & 9.
