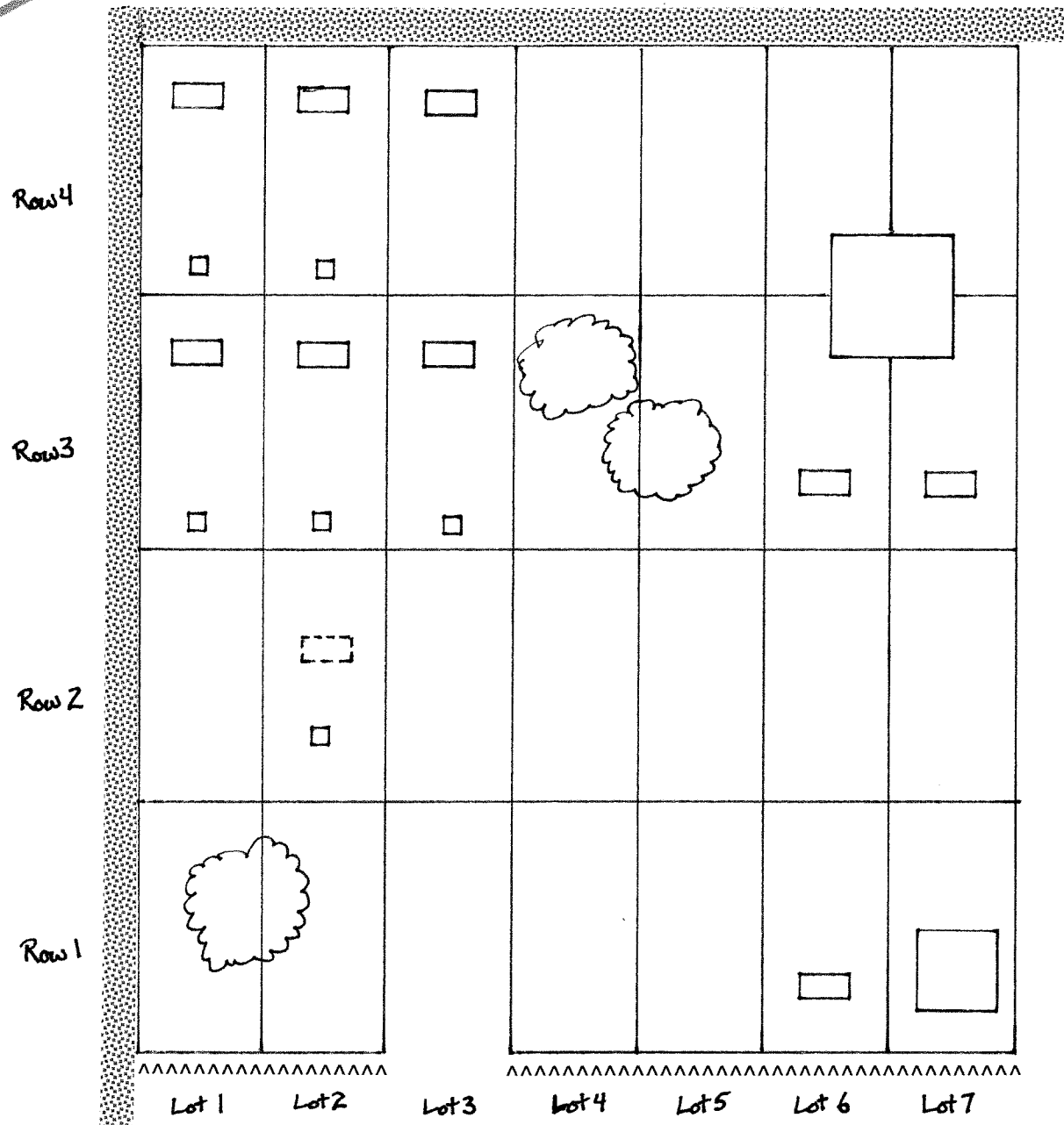


CHAPMAN-ROLLINS CEMETERY

The stones in Lots 1, 2 & 3 appear to have originally been set facing away from the road, with the three in Row 4 having been turned 180° when repaired.

The stones in Lots 6 & 7 were apparently set facing the road at the time of installation.

The Rollins family monument in Row 1, Lot 7 was apparently set in 1908 (year engraved on both ends of the stone). With the exception of George, who has an individual marker, the burial locations are unknown for the individuals named on that monument.

With half the cemetery facing one direction and half the other, it was decided to orient this map based on a visitor's approach from the road.
