


SIDELINGER CEMETERY

NOTES:

- The site was remapped in 2021 after additional fieldstones and depressions were found. Rows and lots were renumbered from the 2018 map to clarify positions corresponding to the new information. (See "Lot # Revisions" for a cross-reference list.)
- The rows are not parallel, which may be a result of various stone repairs over time. That may also account for what appear to be misalignments between some headstone-footstone pairs, and the proximity of some fieldstones to engraved stones. Repaired stones may not have been set precisely in their original locations. It is also possible that some graves were originally marked only with fieldstones that were not removed when engraved stones were set later. No documentation has been found that dates the placement of engraved stones.
- Although a block-shaped stone found near the SE corner has the appearance of a boundary stone, no similar stones were found at the other corners.
- The boundaries drawn are an estimate based on observable grave markers; it is possible the site was originally larger and configured differently than shown.
- Some depressions appear to be associated with fieldstone pairs; others are less obvious.
- The fieldstone outside the bounds to the west may or may not be associated with the depression straddling rows 6 and 7.
- There appear to be at least 7 burials not marked with engraved stones, identities unknown.
