- found reference to a survey done by John Converse in September 1875; plan not found despite extensive research; Converse was a judge, not a surveyor, so the referenced plan was likely a one-of-a-kind
- found documentation for two additional likely burials in Old Hodgdon Yard for which no marker is visible: Clara (Wales) Wortman (d. 1892) and her father Thatcher T. Wales (d. 1897)
- Walpole
  - two missing post caps replaced by J&H
  - found documentation for additional likely burial for which no marker is visible: Dora Woodward (d. 1927)
