- **Hillside**
 - Church Street retaining wall progress
 - columbarium construction details update
 - learned last month RE: St. John's, Essex
 - built 1987
 - original mason deceased
 - originally 120 spaces, now 9 left after 37 years, ~5 people/year
 - \$2,000/space includes opening, closing, bronze plaque & installation
 - changes made at cost
 - only single urns used, standardized size
 - Lorraine seeking to talk to person who opens and closes for information on that process
- **Walpole**
 - one fence post's internal pipe lifted, elevating cap
 - tree work planning
- **calls and contacts**
 - 3/30 – received documentation from family RE: Reno Ouellette's military service
 - 4/3 – met Dusty at Bethlehem RE: E. Gordon urn placement
- **permits**
 - 3/22 – Monument Permit: Sprague bench (Collette to notify us a week prior to installation for location marking)
 - 4/3 – Permit to Open: Ellen Gordon
- **misc.**
 - replace new "Burials Permitted" on **web site** with slightly edited 1/30/2024 version
 - Town Office could only find death records for 2 of the 8 "missing" individuals
 - FAG created a non-existent cemetery with people who are actually buried in Damariscotta
 - database proofreading in process

- **ABGs**
 - DHS needs to replace Nath'l Chapman sign at Reunion Station; Erin at Supplies Unlimited is researching the style used at other sites in the fall of 2018 to see if it can be matched
 - identified George Sidelinger (GR23/Sidelinger) as an 1812 veteran; added to database/flag list; flag holder to be set
 - plan to complete parking pull-off at GR16 pending second DPW employee
 - sizeable pine limb fell at GR160 without damaging stones
