Thank you for signing up to receive notifications on our new platform! If you are forwarding this to someone who has not signed up, they can click [here](#) to do so. If sharing with others, be sure to sign up for notifications through our new [CivicReady](#) platform as well as the app (instructions included when setting up your account), if you choose. Project updates will generally be shared with those who have signed up to receive 'Parking Lot Project' notices. As of 9/16/24, we will push all general project notifications through that platform, so please sign-up if you have not already done so.

Week 1 update...

- Construction workers will be on site today and tomorrow preparing for reclamation. No significant impacts to parking are anticipated leading up to reclamation.
- **Parking Lot CLOSED THURSDAY 9/5** - Reclamation of the existing paved surface will take place on THURSDAY and FRIDAY this week (previously reported as Wednesday and Thursday). We will need all vehicles to be removed from the lot all day Thursday for the crews to complete the majority of this work. The lot will be partially available on Friday. Any vehicles left in the lot at 7 AM on Thursday morning will be removed. Access for freight, trash, boat launch, etc will be available throughout the day with only minor delays while reclaiming is taking place. Please share that with anyone who will be delivering to/picking up from your businesses.
- **Parking Lot Open (mostly) Monday 9/09-Friday 9/13.** The construction crew will be preparing the site for excavation and will only need small, partial closures. The fence will likely be installed towards the end of this week which will consume the area to be closed for much of the project.
- **Parking Lot Closed (mostly) beginning Monday 9/16.** Construction of the stormwater detention system will begin.

The exact schedule will be fluid and you should prepare to be flexible with the available parking. We have identified alternative parking locations and have posted that on our [website](#). Some of you may wish to start using those spaces now to get used to the locations. If you requested a permit for parking at FNB, you are welcome to stop in at the Town Office to pick one up. We did receive more requests than we are able to provide at this time and will work on calling those that will be receiving a permit. This number may increase depending on the use of the lot, which we will work off the existing list to issue.
